DRESS FOR SUCCESS

"We're not just about methods. We're about becoming better people and better leaders."

(Exodus 28:2) Make <u>sacred garments</u> for your brother Aaron to give him <u>dignity and honor</u>.

Five Garments to Dress for Success:

1. The Crown of Holiness over my Mind.

(Exodus 28:36-37) Make a <u>plate</u> of pure gold and <u>engrave</u> on it as on a seal: HOLY TO THE LORD. Fasten a blue cord to it to attach it to the turban; it is to be on the front of the turban.

How much of the secular will I allow in my life to do what God is calling me to do? What am I allowing into my mind that I don't have to?

To make a difference, we have to be different.

2. The Breastplate of Relationships over my Heart.

(Exodus 28:29-30) Whenever Aaron enters the Holy Place, he will bear the <u>names</u> of the sons of Israel over his <u>heart</u> on the <u>breastpiece</u> <u>of decision</u> as a continuing memorial before the LORD. Also put the <u>Urim</u> and the <u>Thummim</u> in the breastpiece, so they may be over Aaron's heart whenever he enters the presence of the LORD. Thus





Aaron will always <u>bear the means of making decisions</u> for the Israelites over his heart before the LORD.

Your heart condition reflects your decision making.

Few things affect the <u>anointing</u> in my life more than <u>my feelings</u> about other <u>people</u>.

3. The Undergarment of Rest over my Life.

(Exodus 28:39) Weave the <u>tunic of fine linen</u> and make the turban of fine linen.

Honor a true Sabbath – have a day to completely disconnect and rest.

Create a weekly pace that is sustainable.

If you learn to say "no", you'll trade popularity for respect.

4. The Garment of Praise in my Spirit.

(Exodus 28:31, 33-35) Make the <u>robe</u> of the ephod entirely of blue cloth... Make pomegranates of blue, purple and scarlet yarn around the hem of the robe, <u>with gold bells</u> between them. The gold bells and the pomegranates are to alternate around the hem of the robe. Aaron must wear it when he ministers. The <u>sound of the bells will be heard</u> when he enters the Holy Place before the LORD and when he comes out.

You have to choose joy.

The key to joy is gratitude.







5. The Oil of <u>Unity</u> over my <u>Head</u>.

(Exodus 29:7) Take the <u>anointing oil</u> and anoint him by pouring it on his head.

Don't be critical of other people, pastors, or other ministries.

Believe the best about people.
